Education, Conservation, Community

The Bluefin Bonanza provides a friendly competition among the top tuna captains in New England but our overall goal is building a better, stronger community.

Scholarships

One way we do that is by providing scholarships to students enrolled in trades and marine sciences programs at each of Maine's 7 community colleges. In just 5 years we have provided over \$100,000 to students and an endowment with the Foundation for Maine's Com-



munity Colleges. These scholarships give students that otherwise lack the means an opportunity to acquire the education and skills necessary to find better paying jobs. In turn, they're providing more qualified workers to local businesses in our community.

Through a collaboration with Carharrt and W.S. Emerson we established a new scholarship program that will provide additional scholarships to community college students enrolled in certain trades.

Another new initiative in 2023 was the Lindsay Withers Memorial Scholarship, which will be awarded to students enrolled in Emergency Medical Services/
Paramedicine program at Southern Maine Community College.






Internships

We also provide internships for students to work at the University of Maine's Pelagic Fisheries Lab at the Gulf of Maine Research Institute. This gives them an opportunity to gain real field experience that will better prepare them for a career in marine sciences.

Research

We've also established a fund with the University of Maine Foundation to support ongoing research by Dr. Walt Golet and his staff at the Gulf of Maine Research Institute. So far we've provided nearly \$100,000 to



support critical research and education associated with highly migratory species important to coastal Maine communities, specifically Atlantic bluefin tuna. Through our support, UMaine undergraduate internships, electronic tagging, and biological monitoring programs for Atlantic bluefin tuna help ensure the long-term viability of this species through development of effective conservation and management approaches.

Education

Our youth education programs give kids a hands-on opportunity to learn about the science of fisheries management.






