2023 Scholarships

Last year was a very successful one for us and we were eager to share the results with our beneficiaries

At the **Southern Maine Community College** campus, we presented a check for \$16,000 to Foundation for Maine's Community Colleges (FMCC) president John Fitzsimmons. These funds will be awarded as \$1,000 scholarships to 14 students, 2 from each of Maine's 7 community colleges enrolled in trades and marine sciences programs and an additional \$1,000 scholarship for two students, one each from Southern Maine Community College and Central Maine Community College. "We deeply appreciate all the work of the Casco Bay Bluefin Bonanza to raise funds for our students," said Fitzsimmons. "Gifts like yours provide an opportunity to attend Maine's community colleges that would otherwise not exist." In addition to annual scholarships, the Bluefin Bonanza also has a \$50,000 endowment with the FMCC that ensures scholarships in perpetuity.



We also awarded a check for \$25,000 to Liz Erickson, Director of Philanthropy at the **University of Maine Foundation**, Dr. Walt Golet, Assistant Professor from the UMaine School of Marine Sciences, and Research Scientist at the Gulf of Maine Research Institute and Diane Rowland, Dean of the UMaine College of Natural Sciences, Forestry, and Agriculture, which oversees the School of Marine Sciences at the University of Maine. "These internships offer an invaluable opportunity for our interns to gain practical field experience and make connections that will help them advance their professional careers," said Golet. "The support also allows the Pelagic Fisheries Lab to increase the scope of our work on bluefin tuna."



Earlier in the fall we presented a check for \$15,000 to The Southern Maine Community College Foundation as the first installment toward our endowment of the Lyndsay Withers Memorial Scholarship, for students enrolled in the SMCC Emergency Medical Services/Paramedicine Program. This will help provide more first responders to rural areas of Maine.



Last but not least, we teamed up with **Carhartt and W.S. Emerson** to provide an additional \$5,000 in scholarships to students from 2 of Maine's community colleges enrolled in specific trades programs. Both businesses understand and appreciate the important contributions these programs make in putting more skilled employees into the local workforce.
